

## **Use of flying site in line with latest Government Covid -19 recommendations May 2020.**

1. The minimum 2 metre social distance rule must be adhered to at all times.
2. No member must go to the site if they have tested positive / are showing symptom's for covid-19 until they have self-isolated for 14 days from the test result / onset of symptoms or been tested negative for covid-19. Members must not come to the site for the time specified, assumed 14 days minimum, if they have been advised they are, or maybe be at risk of covid-19 under the UK Government Track and Trace system. The club will rely on member's integrity on this subject.
3. The number of members at the flight line and pit area any one time must be in line with the latest government social distance information and not exceed 6. Members arriving earlier than their arranged time slot should not approach the flight line or pit area if there are already 6 members present. Visitors or guests of members must not enter the flight line or pit area.
4. In accordance with BMFA Covid 19 guidelines it is strongly recommended all members use face coverings whenever 2metre distancing cannot be maintained. It is also recommended members bring hand sanitiser on site to use
5. A car width of 2> metres must be made between parked vehicles; this may mean having one or more lines of vehicles.
6. Only two aircraft may be in the air at any one time, if other members are assisting pilots i.e. carrying equipment or spotting 2 metre social distance rule applies.
7. It is recommended that members only carry/ move their own models to and from the flight line; any assistance needed must be at the discretion of the member. Please refer to advice note 4 above.
8. Your membership card should be with you as proof of club membership in case any authorised government person queries your access to the site.
9. Members must use the forum to advise that they intend to use the site on any particular day, for those who cannot use the forum please send a text / phone call (07919994086) to the Secretary the day before, this will enable the secretary to add you to the forum list. To help maximise site use an approximate arrival and departure time would enable members to go at different times during daylight.
10. Ultimately, it has to be the individual club members decision whether to go flying or not and to take responsibility for their own and other club members health and safety.
